Letter of Recommendation

I have had the privilege of working with Mr. Todd Biter on a roofing project here at Vanderbilt University. Although Tworivers Roofing was lowest bidder for the project, their workmanship and level of caring was not compromised as is usually the case. The particular project we worked on was for the oldest structures on Vanderbilt Campus, "Old Central" was the original farmhouse built in 1853.
